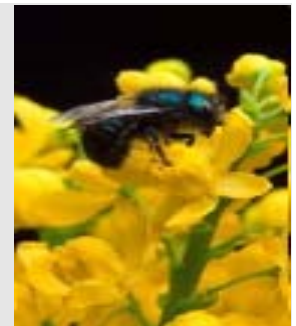
Join the new Executive Committee, featured to the left, of Old Glebe to hear what is planned for the 2010 - 2011 term.

Fort Ethan Allen Monument



The County approved a grant of \$468,000 for the general clean-up and removal of invasive plants, new walkways, interpretive signs, a bas-relief display of the fort, a memorial marker of units that were garrisoned, and a (reproduction) gun emplacement. Design work is nearing completion. This is one of the few 150 civil war anniversary projects that has been approved for Arlington.

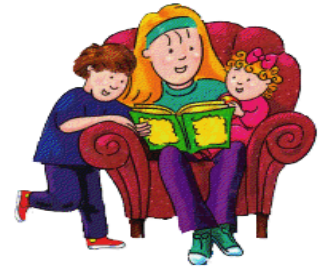

Cranberry-Apple Cobbler Kathy Fong

Cobbler filling:

3 Cups cut up (sliced as if for pie) *un-peeled apples* -red delicious, yellow delicious or your favorite baking type.

2 cups raw cranberries rinsed and small stems removed

1 ½ Cups sugar (use less if you prefer your desserts more tart)

Mix together and pour into a 2 Quart greased casserole

Topping:

1 softened stick butter

½ cup brown sugar

1/3-cup flour

¼ teaspoon salt

1 ½ cups quick oats

½ cup chopped pecans

Mix all ingredients together until evenly topping is somewhat crumbly.



Cover apple-cranberry mixture with the topping mixture, and bake for 1 hour @ 350°.
Watch for topping to brown and for cranberry mix to bubble through.

May be served warm or cool, with a whip cream or vanilla ice cream side- or just plain. Excellent as a side to the turkey, Thanksgiving dessert or with morning coffee cobbler.
